

Home Learning: Reception

In an aim to support you at home with your children we have put together a list of ideas for the 7 areas of learning the EYFS along with some other resources that will be uploaded along with this.

We have tried to make the activities as play based and as fun as possible :).

We have also made a pack for each child- these packs contain a notebook for children to write in/ draw in- these say 'spelling' and 'guided reading' but are to be used for general purposes, they are just old books. There is also a whiteboard and pen- these whiteboards are the ones we use for phonics and have grass, sky and mud lines on them to help with the children's letter formation. You will also have some books in them so you can read together and a pack of post-its. These can be used to encourage children to write labels for their models- please keep these and give them to them when they have a purpose such as labelling.

We are also in the process of adding all your email addresses to evidence.me, our observation app. You will then be able to make a log in and look at all of your children's observations from this school year.

We will be using this to communicate with you- we will add 'observations' with tasks for the children to be doing at home along with phonics support. Please check this regularly so you can support your child.

We understand that this is a difficult situation so please do not worry about sitting your child down to work all day- we do not want anyone to feel stressed. The government is recommending 2 hours of learning a day so if you do a few of the activities a day this will be plenty.
