


Stanley's Cafe by William Bee Book of the Week Activities

Here are some activities to try at home related to the book of the week - Stanley's Cafe (please see video of story).



Monday

Think of some food and drinks that you would like to serve at your own cafe. Ask one of your family to help you make a menu. Maybe you could draw pictures of the food to help people know what each thing is.

Tuesday

Make a sign for your cafe. What would you need to put on your cafe sign? Maybe pictures of food and drinks you serve and when the cafe opens and closes would be useful.

Wednesday

Make some pretend food for your cafe. What could you use to make it? Maybe paper, card (maybe cereal boxes) or playdough?

Thursday

Open your cafe and serve your food and drink! Don't forget your pleases and thank yous when you are serving your customers! Service with a smile!

Friday

Bake a cake like Stanley did in his cafe. Or maybe some cookies. You decide! What ingredients will you need?
