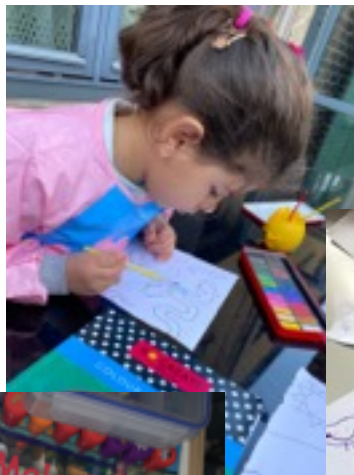




Welcome parents and carers to our Home Learning Newsletter.

Designing, experimenting and problem solving. From making robots (like Joey here) with recycling, to designing games, to experimenting with play-dough.

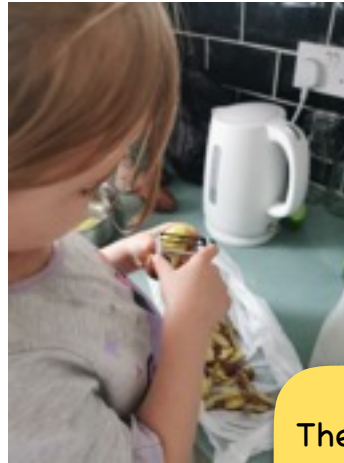


So much creativity with drawings, paintings, story writing and performances. Each activity developing so many skills and opportunities for learning.





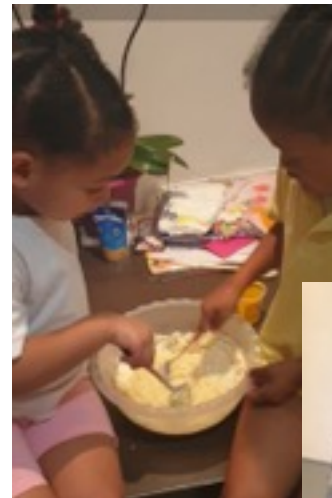
Well done to all the children who have been looking after their bean seeds - I wonder how tall they will grow? *
