Maths

We will beginning this half term with Place Value. The aim is to ensure that the children have a secure understanding of the value of number before we then move onto Addition and Subtraction.

Science

Topic

Phonics: Year one will have the phonics screening check at the end of this year. This is a standardised government assessment that we are required to perform. To support the teaching of phonics, we use 'Little Wandle Phonics'.

PSHE: Zones of Regulation. We will be using zones to help us understand and think about our feelings, what we can do to regulate ourselves so we can be calm, do our best learning and communicate our feelings.

ICT: The focus is on developing our understanding of online safety and presence. We will look at the basics of internet safety, protecting your personal information and what to do if something troubling happens.

English:
