## English

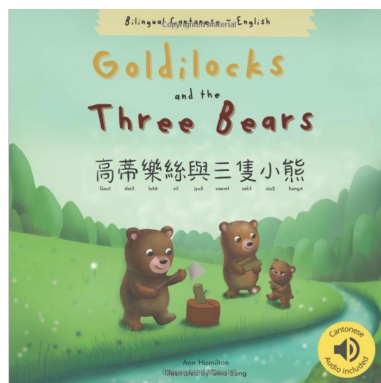
This term, we will be developing our narrative writing skills. We will focus on the genre of 'traditional tales.' Our work will be based on 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.

## Maths

We will start the term with looking at place value, with a specific focus on reading and writing numbers in numerals and words to 100. We will also work on recognising the place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens and ones).

## Science

The focus this half term will be 'Living Things and Their Habitats'.



## Topic

Our topic this half term is the Great Fire of London. The focus questions include 'What materials are best for houses?'

**PSHE:** Zones of Regulation. We will be using Zones to help us: understand and think about our feelings; explore what we can do to regulate ourselves so we can be calm in order to do our best learning and communication.

**R.E:** We will be exploring Hinduism, with a specific focus on Diwali.

**ICT:** Our focus is on developing our understanding of online safety and presence. We will look at how to protect personal information and identity while online and what is suitable online behaviour.

**Music:** We will be learning African call and response songs with an animal theme.

## PE

The days we have P.E. can sometimes vary so please ensure your child has their P.E. kit on a Monday and takes it home on a Friday. Our PE day at the moment is Thursday.

## Reading

Please read at home every day. Your child should bring their reading record and book into school every day. We will change books once a week.
