English

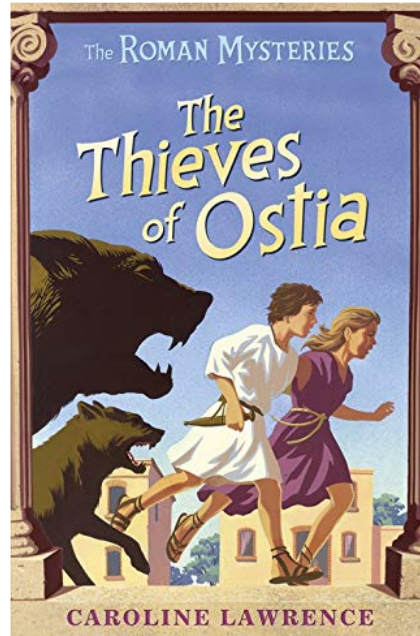
We will be writing a mystery tale based on 'Thieves of Ostia' by Caroline Lawrence. We will also be practising handwriting and spelling.

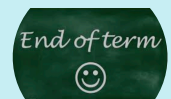
