English

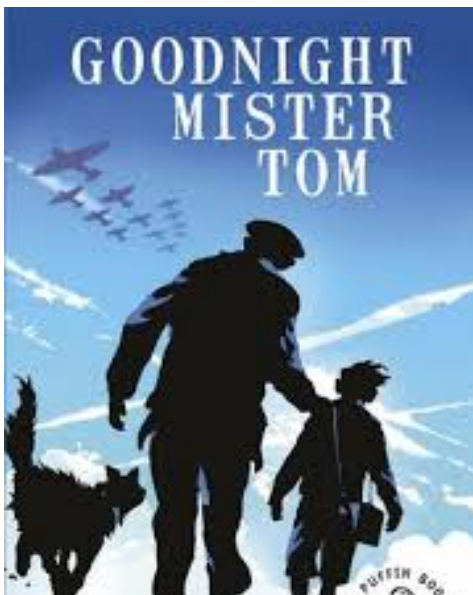
We will read 'Goodnight Mister Tom' and write letters based on text. We will also use it as a springboard to learn more about WW2.

Maths

We will begin the year by looking at place value and numbers past 1,000,000. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, followed by multiplication and division.

Science

Our focus will be on classification of living things, followed by learning about the human heart and circulation system.



Topic

Our topic this half term is the Second World War. The focus questions include: How significant was the Blitz? WW2: Whose War? What was the impact of WW2 on our locality?

PSHE: Zones of Regulation. We will be using zones to help us understand and think about our feelings, what we can do to regulate ourselves so we can be calm, do our best learning and communicating. We will then move on to talk about society and the experiences of refugees.

R.E: We will be exploring Buddhism: The Buddha's Teachings.

ICT: Our focus is on developing our understanding of online safety and presence. We will look at how to protect personal information and identity while online through the use of strong passwords and what is suitable online behaviour.
