In Maths we will first look at multiplication and division, specifically multiples, factors, prime numbers, cube and square numbers. We will then move onto fractions.

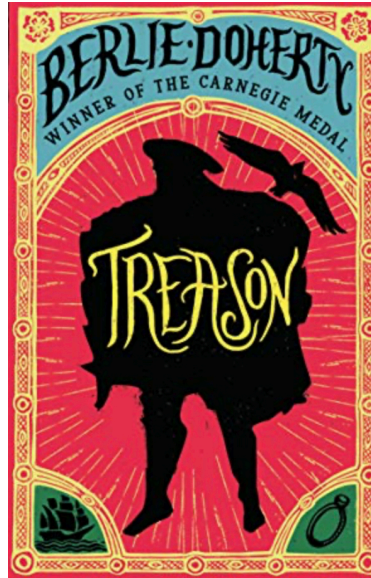
Science
