Please come along and join us for a cuppa and a chat. It's a fantastic opportunity to meet other parents in an informal environment. Refreshments will be provided.

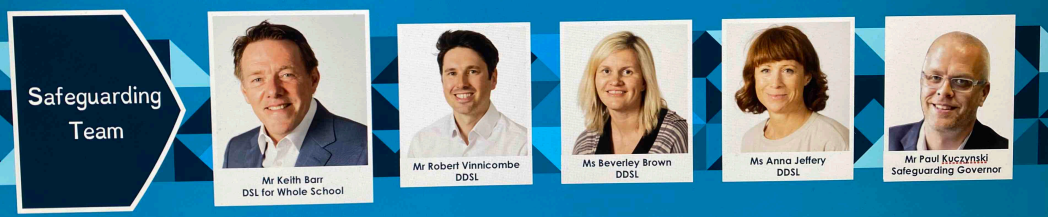
