The first week back we are celebrating 150 years of Kender Primary School. On Wednesday 5th June the children will take part in a Victorian day, learning what life was like as a Victorian child. They will be looking at a range of sources that depict the history of Kender school. Following on from this each class has a decade to learn about:

This learning will take place as part of their History and Geography lessons.

After the 150 celebrations our summer project is 'Photography' the children will learn about the photographer Martin Parr. They will visit Bold Tendencies' in Peckham to look at Martin Parr's photograph called 'Beach Therapy'. This is one of a number of art works commissioned by Bold Tendencies this year on their theme of 'Communion'.

The children will then create art work inspired by the photograph.

Now your turn mums, dads and carers - Over the half term we would like the children to look at family photographs past and present and bring these into school to share with the class. We would also like them to talk to family members about the decade that their class is learning about (see above) and bring in artefacts such as clothes, photographs, objects that are from their decade.
