BOLD TENDENCIES – is a creative arts space based in a multi-story Car-Park in the Centre of Peckham.

MY MUSEUM is a project run by Bold Tendencies which gives control to children to use objects and create their own MUSEUM exhibitions. MY MUSEUM is designed to let children tell their own stories and represent who they are and how they relate to their community. It is as a resource for the children in our locality, whether Pupils in neighbouring schools and/or of the families that visit our site.

The first exhibition in the space is called “HOME & AWAY” and includes contributions from four schools, Bellenden Primary, Kender Primary, Dulwich Hamlet, and Harris Academy Peckham Park.

We are organising a special viewing of the current exhibition on the Wednesday 28 September. Children from all four schools and parents who wish to come are welcome between 15.30 – 18.30. We really hope that as many people as possible will chose to come.

Directions to the BOLD TENDENCIES car-park from Peckham Rye Station:

Walk straight out of the station and go straight ahead until you hit Rye Lane. Turn left. When you reach McDonalds, cross the road at the traffic lights.

Go straight ahead, past Santander Bank. You will see the Peckham Plex Cinema in front of you.

Turn to your right and next to it on your left you will find a set of stairs with the Bold Tendencies sign next to them. Go up these stairs and you will reach a pink foyer- you have gone to the right place!

If you see the sign for ‘Peckham Levels’ or have walked around the corner of the car STOP! You have gone too far past the Peckham Plex!
