

PE and Sports Premium 2023/2024: £17250

Breakdown of spend

- All children have at least an hour per week of good quality learning in Sports/Health-related learning
- Girls and Boys School Football teams compete in Borough wide competitions – holds two trophies for football for teams in Y3&4 and Y5&6
- Whole school participation in annual Sports Day at Goldsmith's Sports Field
- After School Clubs for: Multi-Sports, Football and Cricket attended by approximately 140 children each half term
- 100% of children take part in annual Health week, events include: Kender Mile, Yoga, HIIT training, Healthy Eating
- Children in Yrs5 and 6 have access to Professional Bikeability Cycle Training
- School Journey for children in Year Six; climbing, kayaking, canoeing...
- All children have access to at least an hour of Platinum rated Outdoor Play based learning
- Garden Clubs and Forest School
- Platform Cricket for Year Four
- School worked with Better Leisure to provide swimming for children in Years 3 and 4
- Participation in the Deptford Green Outreach programme
- Supporting children to organize and manage Five-a-side football tournaments

Measurable impact

- Ofsted, October 2019: school curriculum is good
- Attendance across the school improving: Summer 2024 96.7%
- Behaviour and wellbeing: Ofsted rating remains outstanding
- All children have at least an hour each week of good quality learning in Sports/Health Related learning
- Children spending more time in lessons; learning starts more quickly after lunchtimes
- Access to creative and inclusive has led to Children's mental health improving
- Higher % of children from disadvantaged or BAME backgrounds playing cricket
- 97% of children in Y3 and 100% of children in Y4 accessed swimming
- Children who attend sports clubs: consistently above 95% attendance
