English

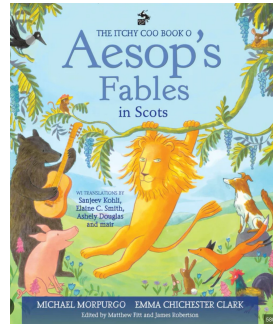
This term, we will be learning about fables such as: The Boy who cried Wolf, The Hare and the Tortoise, The Fox and the Crow, The North Wind and the Sun.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction and shape. Children will be taught to add and subtract 1 and 2 digit numbers. Children will also be taught to bridge 10 and will be shown a variety of methods to support their learning.

Topic

This half term we will be learning about 'Schools in the past' in **History**. We will be looking at how school has changed over time. If you have any pictures to share with us, please send them via email to me.

Next half term in **Geography**, we will be exploring living in the different regions of the world and whether we would prefer to live in a hot or cold place.

PSHE: In PSHE, we will be exploring friendships and what it means to be a good friend. Children will think about how they can show they are a good friend and how to acknowledge when someone is being a good friend.

R.E: We will be exploring Hinduism with specific focus on believing stories.

ICT: Our focus is on developing our understanding of online safety and presence. We will look at how to protect personal information and identity while online and what is suitable online behaviour.

Music: We will continue to learn call and response songs with an animal theme.

DT: The children will be designing and creating a functional fairground wheel.
