Year 5: During English, year 5 have been looking at characters from the great story, Oliver Twist. In Topic they have been looking at how Victorian Transport changed through out time and have been learning how to add and subtract using column method in Maths.

MOSAIC CLASS FOR PARENTS

Many of our parents will remember Joni McDougall who worked with us to make our lovely Respect patchwork. Joni is an acclaimed mosaic artist and professional member of the British Association for Modern Mosaic. She will be running a course with us to make a beautiful mosaic – from developing your own design to making a stunning piece of mosaic art for your home or garden. The two term course is suitable for beginners and experienced artists.

The cost to students will be £30 to for two terms; this will cover full tuition, use of tools and basic materials.

Term One starts on Friday 13 January 2017 from 9.00 to 11.30. In the first term students will learn mosaic techniques and work on an individual panel, from your own unique design, approx 30cm x 30 cm. In Term Two, students will work collectively on a panel for Kender School.
