The children have settled into Year 3 brilliantly and are already becoming familiar with their new routines and expectations. We are looking forward to a busy and exciting term of learning together.



English

This term, we will be exploring fables. The children will read and discuss a range of traditional fables, looking closely at their characters, structure and morals. They will then use what they have learnt to plan, write and publish their own fables.



Maths

Our main focus will be place value. Children will develop their understanding of numbers to 1000, representing numbers in different ways and exploring tens, ones and hundreds. We will then begin to apply this understanding to addition and subtraction.



Science

Our Science topic is Skeletons and Movement. Children will identify and name bones in the human body, explore the purpose of a skeleton and compare the skeletons of different animals. Later in the term, we will investigate joints and how our bodies move.



PE

The days we have P.E. can sometimes vary so please ensure your child has their P.E. kit on a Monday and takes it home on a Friday.

Reading

Please read at home every day. Your child should bring their reading record and book into school every day. We will change books once a week.

Homework will be set each week.

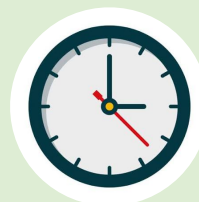
