Please see this extract from our Attendance Policy:

The (Government) regulations make it clear that parents do not have any right or entitlement to take a child out of school for the purposes of a term time holiday. If parents take their child on holiday during term time this will be counted as unauthorised absence – this is an illegal absence.

Term time absence will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Each request will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
